

DRESS CODE

Students should follow the Dress-Code mentioned below or else they shall be sent back home.

Girl-Students

- ❖ Should wear properly tailored school-uniform. Tight-fitting, indecent school-uniform will not be allowed.
- ❖ Girl-students from Class : NURSERY - ONE to Class - EIGHT should wear white knee-high stockings and not **leggings or churidar** along with their uniform.
- ❖ Hair should not be left loose. It must be neatly managed with black ribbons/bands and/or clips. Fancy hair styles, application of gels, hair dyes (except black) will not be allowed.
- ❖ Black shoes should be properly cleaned everyday. High-heel footwear will not be allowed.
- ❖ Gold ornaments should not be worn.
- ❖ Use of cosmetics should be very minimum. Use of perfumes, lipsticks and eyeliners are strictly prohibited.
- ❖ School-Tie; School-Badge and School-Belt should not appear to be shabby, torn or discoloured.

Boy-Students

- Should wear properly tailored school-uniform. They should not wear low-waist, narrow bottom trousers. The trousers should be of the traditional formal type with pleats, straight-pockets with bottom (ankle) measurement not less than 16 inches. **If any boy-student is found wearing trousers not conforming to the school's norms he will not be allowed to attend school.**
- Boy-students should have their shirts properly tucked in. Shabby, not properly ironed, discoloured uniform will not be allowed.
- Boy-students should wear typical black-shoes meant for school-students and not the narrow - tipped trendy ones.
- Hair should be regularly trimmed. Hair-style of the boy-students should be of the traditional type. No trendy hair-style will be allowed.
- School-Tie; School-Badge and School-Belt should not appear to be shabby, torn or discoloured.
